

# Miner's Way Cycle Trail

The White Cliffs Countryside Project has created the cycle trail, in collaboration with Spokes, to accompany the Miner's Way Walking Trail. The cycle route meanders for approximately 30 miles through beautiful countryside linking the industrial heritage the former mining villages of East Kent, the Coalfield Parishes.

## Rules of the road

Some things to remember as you cycle through the countryside:

- follow the Highway Code
- make sure you've been seen - most accidents involving cyclists happen at junctions
- use lights and reflective clothing in poor visibility
- consider wearing a helmet and brightly coloured clothing
- keep your bike roadworthy
- don't cycle on pavements except where designated
- use your bell to alert pedestrians when sharing road or a designated path
